Fall 2025

The activity tables are used to report on project deliverables, participants and acres. It is submitted with the application, as well as with interim and final reports. Use this guide to better understand what is required by the table and how to complete it properly.

Part I: Project Activities

Activity Number

This column requires no input from the grantee. It is used to automatically assign a number to each project activity so it can be easily referenced in the subsequent tables.

Activity or Event

This column requests that grantees describe each activity/event they plan to deliver through the project. These explanations may be brief but should provide administrators with a general idea of what the event will entail.

Location (City/Town)

Here, the grantee should identify the city or town and the province where each activity should take place.

Activity Number

This column requires no input from the grantee. It correlates with the Activity Number in Part I and represents each activity with a number.

Type of Participants

This column requires the grantee to identify the type(s) of participants each activity seeks to engage. Examples may include, but are not limited to:

- Landowners
- Teachers
- Students
- Youth (generally)
- Volunteers
- Hunters
- Community members
- General public

Type of Participant Engagement

Here, the grantee is required to indicate the type of engagement that each activity seeks to deliver. This should identify the way in which the participants will engage in the activity. Examples may include, but are not limited to:

- In person
- Online
- Social media engagement

Estimated Number of Participants

This column requires that the grantee estimate the number of participants to be engaged in each activity. The number is expected to be an estimate and the grantee will have the opportunity to adjust it as the program year goes on and as actual numbers become available.

Activity Number

This column requires no input from the grantee. It correlates with the Activity Number in Part I and represents each activity with a number.

Direct Support by WHC Grant Funds

Answer this question with YES or NO using the drop-down menu. Answer YES, if the activity will use WHC funds. Answer NO, if the activity does not use WHC funds.

Associated Habitat Acres

Answer this question with YES or NO using the drop-down menu. Answer YES, if the activity conserved, enhanced or restored acres using WHC funds. Answer NO, if the activity did not conserve, enhance or restore acres using WHC funds.

NAWMP Activity Category

In this column, the grantee should select from the drop-down menu the relevant category for the activity. Please refer to the [NAWMP Activity Category Guide](#) before selecting the relevant initiative.

Type of Habitat

This column requires the grantee to select from the drop-down menu what kind of habitat acres, if any, each activity will conserve, enhance or restore. If the activity does not have any associated acres, please select "None".

Estimated Number of Acres

This column requires that the grantee estimate the number of acres to be conserved, enhanced or restored in each activity. The number is expected to be an estimate and the grantee will have the opportunity to adjust it as the program year goes on and as actual numbers become available. If no acres will be impacted, please input "0".
